

Woolen Mill "Picker"

Located on the site of the Woolen Mill. Wool was a major industry in Reedsburg from 1882 to 1967. The mill was destroyed by fire April 9, 1968. This wheel was part of a "picker" used to clean the wool and remove the clumps before it went to the carding room where it was combed into strands.

As an historic remnant of the Woolen Mill, this wheel serves as a symbol of recognition for the thousands of people who worked there, weaving the fabric of Reedsburg's future.

This marker is located outside of the building at 16 East Main Street currently the Bent and Dent store.
