The Public Works Committee for the City of Reedsburg convened for their regular meeting, on July 15, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. in the Reedsburg Center Conference Room with the following members present:

Members Present: Brandt Werner, Dave Knudsen, Megan Cowan and Charlie Backeberg.

Also Present: Steve Zibell Public Works Director/City Engineer, Ken Witt City Administrator and Chris Kleinschmit WWTP Manager.

Motion by Knudsen seconded by Cowan to approve the minutes from June 17, 2015 meetings.

Motion Carried

Kleinschmit presented the CMAR and went over each section. Kleinschmit stated the reasons for the lower grades were due to the influent loadings to the plant, sludge storage and Chris wasn't fully a Class 4 operator last year. Chris is currently is so this grade will change next year and Chris stated the sludge storage is being looked at. There was discussion amongst the members. Zibell stated the City was working on the sludge storage issue and had a couple possible solutions. Motion by Cowan seconded by Knudsen to approve the CMAR for the wastewater treatment plant.

Zibell stated the solid waste contract will end this year and we could re-bid the contract or try and negotiate a new contract with Peterson. Ken stated our current cost is in line with other Communities. The committee felt it would be best to negotiate with Peterson since we haven't had any problems with their service. Motion by Knudsen seconded by Backeberg to negotiate a contract with Peterson and bring it back to Public Works next month.

Zibell presented the CIP plan. Zibell proposed rebuilding North Preston Avenue from Main Street to LaValle Street, North Albert Ave from Main Street to W. Second Street, West Second Street from N. Albert Ave. to Eagle Street and South Willow Street from Main Street to Lucky Street in 2016. Also move North Dewey Avenue from 8<sup>th</sup> Street to 21<sup>st</sup> Street to 2017. South Dewey Ave. from Main to the Railroad Tracks will be done in 2018 and 19<sup>th</sup> Street from North Dewey to Viking Drive is proposed to be done in 2019. There was discussion amongst the members. Zibell also proposed replacing one of the HVAC units on the Fire Department building. Motion by Cowan seconded by Backeberg to forward the recommendations for the CIP to the Finance Committee.

Motion Carried

Motion by Backeberg seconded by Cowan to adjourn.
