The Public Works Committee for the City of Reedsburg convened for their regular meeting, on July 16, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. in the Reedsburg Center Conference Room with the following members present:

Also Present: Steve Zibell Public Works Director/City Engineer, Ken Witt City Administrator, and Chris Kleinschmit WWTP Manager.

Motion by Backeberg seconded by Cowan to approve the minutes from June 19, 2014 meeting.

Zibell presented 3 options for Mittlesteadt Drive, one was to rebuild the street with curb and gutter, second was to pulverize and overlay and the third was a double chip seal. The committee felt due to cost and the unknown of development at this time the double chip seal option was the best at this time. Zibell stated the cost would be around \$12,000 for the double seal. Motion by Borucki seconded by Backeberg to double chip seal Mittlesteadt Drive.

Witt gave a brief update on the City Hall projects. There was some discussion amongst the members but no action was taken.

Zibell and Kleinschmit presented a proposal to re-build the Thomas Road lift station. Zibell stated the pumps are starting to show their age and the control panel parts are becoming harder to find. Chris also stated the controllers in the panel have been giving him problems. Zibell also stated the problem with wipes plugging the pumps. Zibell stated the funding would come from the wwtp replacement fund. Motion by Borucki seconded by Backeberg to go ahead with the proposal for the Thomas Road lift station.
