The Public Works Committee for the City of Reedsburg convened for their regular meeting, on August 20, 2014 at 5:00 p.m. in the Reedsburg Center Conference Room with the following members present:

Members Present: Dave Knudsen, Brandt Werner, Greg Borucki, Megan Cowan and Charlie Backeberg.

Also Present: Steve Zibell Public Works Director/City Engineer and Ken Witt City Administrator

Motion by Borucki seconded by Backeberg to approve the minutes from July 16 and August 7, 2014 meetings.

Motion Carried

Zibell presented a request from a citizen to place a stop sign on Myrtle Street at the intersection of Fourth Street. To committee felt this was a speed issue and weren't in favor of this request. No action was taken.

Zibell discussed removing some of the asphalt from the alley way between Booster Blvd. and Division Street. Zibell explained they would remove the topsoil and seed most of the existing alley. The portion from the east would remain up to 624 Booster Blvd. The commission discussed this and liked the idea. Cowan asked about drainage and Zibell stated this would help with the drainage since we would be removing the impervious material and we can re-grade some of the area when the topsoil is placed. Motion by Backeberg seconded by Knudsen to proceed with the removal of the asphalt and replace with topsoil between 510 and 624 Booster Blvd along with re-grading and paving the east end when possible.

Motion Carried

Werner presented an affidavit of correction to change Mittlesteadt Drive from the bridge to Barbara Ann Drive. Motion by Cowan seconded by Borucki to change the name from Mittlesteadt Drive to Barbara Ann Drive.

Motion Carried

Werner presented an ordinance to change the speed limit on Mittlesteadt Drive from 45mph to 35 mph. Motion by Knudsen seconded by Backeberg to change the speed limit on Mittlesteadt Drive to 35 mph.

Motion Carried

Zibell and Witt presented the equipment replacement fund to the committee. There was some discussion about the equipment and everyone agreed with the list presented.

Zibell and Witt presented the Capital Improvement Plan. Zibell stated North Grove was on the list to be done next year. Everyone agreed with this along with the future year's street improvements as presented. Witt also talked about replacing the rest of the ceiling tile at City Hall, Carnegie outside steps replacement, LED exterior lighting on all the City buildings and replacing an HVAC system at the Fire Department.

Motion by Werner seconded by Knudsen to adjourn.
