The Public Works Committee for the City of Reedsburg convened for their regular meeting, on May 18, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the Reedsburg Center Conference Room with the following members present:

Motion by Seamonson seconded by Backeberg to approve the minutes from April 20, 2016 meetings.

Zibell discussed possibility of making South Willow Street from Main Street to Plum Street one-way south. Pete Peterson and Jessica Bauer presented a petition with 22 signatures asking to consider this. The committee discussed which direction to make it one-way and the consensus was to go south. Zibell stated the real only costs for the city to do this were a few signs and the ordinance creation. Motion by Craker seconded by Backeberg to make South Willow Street one-way south from East Main Street to Plum Street starting after the construction work is finished.

Motion Carried

Zibell discussed options to replace the loop detectors for some signalized intersections. Zibell stated the current loops are under the pavement and some work and some don't. They have been fixed in the past but they seem to work intermittently. Another option is to use a digital camera system. Zibell explained the technology has been around for years and is currently very dependable, accurate and less expensive. Zibell estimated \$8,000 to do an intersection. The thought is to try this on Dewey and Viking Drive first before we go ahead with the other intersections downtown. The consensus of the committee was to move forward with at least one intersection and two if the price is reasonable and within our budget.
