

City of Reedsburg Meeting of the Common Council
February 24, 2014

Mayor Estes called the regular session of the Common Council to order at 7:00pm in the Common Council Chambers.

Moved by Craker and seconded by Heuer to approve the consent agenda, consisting of Minutes from the Council meeting held on February 10, 2014; Operator license for Brianna Parker. Motion carried 9-0.

Mayor Estes called a public hearing to order for Ordinance 1787-14 Height/Mobile Towers. No public comments. **Moved by Heuer and seconded by Cowan to approve Ordinance 1787-14 Height/Mobile Towers. Motion carried 9-0 on a roll call vote.**

Mayor Estes called a public hearing to order for Ordinance 1788-14 Nonconforming Uses and Structures. No public comments. **Moved by Knudsen and seconded by Glick to approve Ordinance 1788-14 Nonconforming Uses and Structures. Motion carried 9-0 on a roll call vote.**

Mayor Estes called a public hearing to order for Ordinance 1789-14 Archery Hunting within City Limits. No public comments. **Moved by Craker and seconded by Knudsen to approve Ordinance 1789-14 Archery Hunting within City Limits. Motion carried 9-0 on a roll call vote.**

Joann Mundth Douglas presented the Ruminant public art project for the Council to consider for a Webb Fund grant. The Council asked to also discuss the next agenda item, which was the location and maintenance of the Ruminant project. The Council discussed the ongoing maintenance cost would be minimal. The location across from the Chamber Depot does have some traffic visibility issues at the nearby intersection. **Moved by Peterson and seconded by Heuer to approve location of Ruminant public art on lot behind the police station, across from the Chamber Depot and be responsible for ongoing maintenance of the public art. Motion carried on a vote of 7-2 with Werner and Knudsen voting against the project.**

Discussion returned to grant funding and the amount of the request. **Moved by Heuer and seconded by Peterson to approve \$18,000 Webb Fund grant for Ruminant public art project. Motion carried on a roll call vote 5-4 with Werner, Knudsen, Finnegan and Glick voting against the motion.**

Moved by Heuer and seconded by Werner to adjourn. Motion carried 9-0. Meeting adjourned at 7:31pm.
