

City of Reedsburg Meeting of the Common Council

March 23, 2015

Council President Dave Knudsen called the regular session of the Common Council to order at 7:00pm in the Common Council Chambers.

Moved by Heuer and seconded by Craker to approve the consent agenda, consisting of Minutes from the Council meeting held on March 9, 2015; Operator License for Chris Tourdot. Motion carried 8-0.

Public hearing was called to order for Ordinance 1798-15 creating Section 8.09 Trees and Shrubs. No comments from the public. **Moved by Moon and seconded by Cowan to adopt Ordinance 1798-15. Motion carried 8-0 on a roll call vote.**

Public hearing was called to order for Ordinance 1799-15 changing zoning of parcel 276-2245-10000, 600 S. Golf Course Road from Agricultural to I-4 Business Park. No comments from the public. **Moved by Heuer and seconded by Finnegan to adopt Ordinance 1799-15. Motion carried 8-0 on a roll call vote.**

Public hearing was called to order for Ordinance 1800-15 amending Section 12.01(14) Intoxicating Liquors in Parks. Chief Becker spoke against the ordinance, concerned about the ball players consuming alcohol and having bats. Parks Director Matt Scott said the ordinance made the rules the same for all parks and would promote the return of softball leagues to Reedsburg. The Council debated the removal of alcohol restrictions on the ball fields of Oak, Ramsey and Nishan Parks. The ordinance amendment would allow alcohol consumption in all parks, except at the swimming pool. **Moved by Peterson and seconded by Craker to adopt Ordinance 1800-15. Motion carried on a roll call vote 5-3 with Moon, Schulte and Werner voting against the motion.**

Moved by Werner and seconded by Schulte to accept the low bids for 2015 construction projects. Motion carried 8-0.

Moved by Werner and seconded by Finnegan to accept bid by Vierbicher for South Dewey Avenue engineering contract. Motion carried 8-0.

Moved by Werner and seconded by Cowan to adopt Resolution 4218-15 ordering the repair and installation of sidewalk on various streets in areas G & H on the south east side of the City. Motion carried 8-0.

Moved by Heuer and seconded by Craker to approve Certified Survey Map dividing parcel 030-0566-10000 at E6681 Enterprise Drive for Dennis Laukant & Michele Sullivan. Motion carried 7-0 with Cowan abstaining.

Alder Schulte discussed the new Historic Preservation logo and projects the Commission is working on in Nishan Park and Harvest Park.

Moved by Cowan and seconded by Heuer to adjourn. Motion carried 8-0. Meeting adjourned at 7:34pm.
