

# City of Reedsburg Meeting of the Common Council

Mayor Estes called the regular session of the Common Council to order at 7:00pm in the Common Council Chambers.

**Approve Consent Agenda:** Consisting of minutes from the Council meeting held on June 13, 2016 and January 11, 2016 (amended minutes).

Consideration of Ordinance 1835-16 Municipal Court of City of Reedsburg, Town of LaValle and the Village of Rock Springs: 2<sup>nd</sup> reading. No Action Taken.

Consider an amended Planned Development Group/Conditional Use permit for a multi-family building consisting of 33 apartments and a parking lot – 201, 221 & 23 S. Walnut St; Parcel #s 1015, 1016 & 1017 – Cohen-Esrey Affordable Partners. No Action Taken.

Consideration of rezoning: 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of Ordinance 1832-16 – Lindloff property: Parcel #030-0036-00000. No public comment.

**Motion: Knudsen, Second: Finnegan to approve Ordinance 1832-16, Rezoning of Lindloff property Parcel 030-0036-00000. Motion Carried 8-1 with Craker voting Nay.**

Consideration of 1833-16 ATV/UTV Ordinance and Map: 2<sup>nd</sup> reading. Dick Fish and Dan Fleming, members of the Sauk Ridge Runners ATV Club, gave a brief history of other routes in area and their club. Many citizens are in favor of the route.
