Moved by Moon and seconded by Cowan to set July 27, 2015 public hearing on Ordinance 1812-15 deleting Section 4.06 special peace officers.

Moved by Moon and seconded by Peterson to set July 27, 2015 public hearing on Ordinance 1813-15 creating Section 7.20(13) bicycle control of operation on sidewalks.

Public Works Director Zibell reviewed bids for the new airport terminal building. Low bid by Friede & Associates of \$782,731.10. City portion will only be \$41,347 with the balance coming from state and federal funding. **Moved by Finnegan and seconded by Schulte to approve low bid of \$782,731.10 by Friede & Associates for airport terminal building. Motion carried 9-0.**

Committee Chairs gave background reports on the status of projects at the committee level.

Moved by Cowan and seconded by Finnegan to adjourn. Motion carried 9-0. Meeting adjourned at 7:18pm.
