

City of Reedsburg Meeting of the Common Council

September 14, 2015

Mayor Estes called the regular session of the Common Council to order at 7:00pm in the Common Council Chambers.

Mike McCarville from the High School invited the Council and public to an open house on Wednesday at 5pm for the start of the 101 Vine Street rehab program in partnership between the City and School.

Moved by Heuer and seconded by Craker to approve the consent agenda, consisting of minutes from the Council meeting held on August 24, 2015; Approval of August paid bills; Operator Licenses for Clara Bass, Jimmy Berry, Tamara Clark, Nancy Hornack, Jessica Janusiak, Teri Nelson, Brianna Risser-Stolte; Special Event Permit for Preschool Pumpkin Dance Party in City Park on October 24th from 3-5:15pm, with waiver of fee; Temporary Class "B"/"Class B" retailer licenses for the Wormfarm Institute for October 2-11th Fermentation Fest activities at 28 E. Main Street, 170 E. Main Street, 146 Railroad Street and 305 E. Main Street; Temporary Class "B" retailer licenses for Reedsburg Revitalization Organization Barley Stroll on October 2, 2015 at 14 downtown locations; Temporary Class "B" retailer license for RAMC Foundation for Tailgate Extravaganza on November 7th at 2090 Ridgeview Drive. Motion carried 9-0.

Public hearing on Ordinance 1814-15 parking in front of yellow curbs. No public comment. **Moved by Peterson and seconded by Finnegan to adopt Ordinance 1814-15 Parking Restrictions. Motion carried 9-0 on a roll call vote.**

Moved by Knudsen and seconded by Cowan to set public hearing date of September 28, 2015 for Ordinance 1816-15 mobile home definitions and electrical licensing.

Moved by Heuer and seconded by Schulte to approve Certified Survey Map to divide one parcel into three at 1351 21st Street, parcel 2586. Motion carried 9-0.

Moved by Werner and seconded by Moon to approve Resolution 4226-15 Exemption from County Library Tax Levy. Motion carried 9-0.

Committee Chairs gave reports on their committees.

Moved by Cowan and seconded by Craker to go into closed session jointly with the Reedsburg Utility Commission per sec. 19.85(1)(b), Stats., to consider dismissal, demotion, or discipline of any public employee under its jurisdiction and to consider the taking of formal action in that regard and pursuant to sec. 19.85(1)(c), Stats. to consider employment and performance evaluation data and information regarding the Utility Department. Motion carried 9-0. Closed session discussion occurred here.

Moved by Heuer and seconded by Glick to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 8:58pm.
