



HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION MINUTES

Approval of Minutes

Motion by Birdd, seconded Braunschweig by to approve the 12/8/15 minutes.

Consider Nishan Plaque for City Hall.

Gnatzig presented a plaque quote of \$450. Two other quotes were \$900 and \$1400. Discussion was held on who would pay for the plaque, the Commission or City Council.

Motion by Smith, seconded by Birdd to request that Council pay for the City Hall plaque. It will be requested at the 1st February meeting.

Consider historic driving tour.

Smith presented a draft of the 101 Vine St narrative. He stated that they worked on the timing and may practice the route with SCHCC residents. Planning has been done for 3-5 years' worth of tours. Discussion was held on additional funding and possibly holding it on Founders Day too.

Motion by Liegel, seconded by Braunschweig to approve applying for the Sauk County AHHP Grant.

Motion carried

Consider local television history segment.

Discussion was held on eight potential topics, such as Agnes Moorehead, Clare Briggs, baseball, POW camp, Miss Wis Pageant, and deceased notable residents. Gnatzig and Braunschweig will continue to work on it and report back.

Consider funding and application of Nishan Chapel for National Register.

Liegel stated that she has worked on it with Birdd and Duvalle. They plan to meet with Dale Suemnicht to gather additional information.

Motion by Liegel, seconded by Birdd to adjourn at 5:50 pm.
