

# City of Reedsburg Ordinance Committee Minutes

## May 23, 2016

Phil Peterson called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

- I. Moved by Finnegan and seconded by B. Peterson to approve minutes from the January 25, 2016 meeting. Motion carried 4-0.
  
- II. General Business
  1. Code of Ethics: All Committee members present acknowledged the annual review - Ethics Policy and they have turned in the signed copies to the annual review to the City Administrator.
  
  2. ATV Ordinance and Map: The committee members discussed the ordinance and course depicted on the map. Additionally, there was discussion about licenses, liability and placing a sunset provision into the Ordinance. Attorney Gerlach discussed the pros and cons of placing sunset language in an ordinance. Attorney Gerlach recommended the best course of action would be to have the Administration bring the item back up for the annual review. Chief Becker spoke to the risk, insurance requirements and enforcement efforts. **Motion moved by Finnegan and seconded by B. Peterson to approve and recommend to the City Council. Motion carried 4-0.**
  
  3. Operator's License Application – Peter Peterson III: Review of Operator's Licenses application denied previously. Ordinance Committee members discussed and heard from the applicant and the business owner where the applicant will be working. The Committee members asked Chief Becker for his recommendation. Chief Becker indicated the policy only lets him recommend a denial at this time and for the near future. Operator's License Application must be approved annually. **Motion moved by Finnegan and seconded by B. Peterson to approve and recommend to the City Council. Motion carried 4-0.**
