

City of Reedsburg Ordinance Committee Minutes

June 27, 2016

David Moon called the meeting to order at 5:59 pm.

- I. Moved by Seamonson and seconded by B. Peterson to approve minutes from the May 2, 2016. Motion carried 5-0.

- II. General Business
 1. Discuss Introduction and 1st reading of Ordinance 1835-16. Municipal Court of City of Reedsburg, Town of LaValle and Village of Rock Springs. Atty Gerlach presented the Ordinance and circumstances surrounding the needs and desire for Rock Springs to come into the Reedsburg Court. Chief Becker brought up concerns about issuance of citations, court processing concern and the overall cost picture. A further concern was raised that the City of Reedsburg might be subsidizing administration costs. There were no actions on the item at this time.

- III. City Engineer and Public Works Director Zibell made a request of the Ordinance Committee to review an ordinance making South Willow one-way from E. Main to Plum Street. This street has been recommended for this change by the Public Works Board. Peterson and seconded by B. Peterson to forward to City Council for action.
 2. Interim City Administrator presented a discussion about the use of contracted services of Municode to assist the city in codification of the Municipal Code. The process of updating the municipal code was explored. Administrator Compton discussed the way updates are done in the Clerk Office for the Municipal Code. This was one of the top desires of the Interim City Clerk and office staff as the update process is currently behind. Initial cost is estimated to be \$9,850 with an annual maintenance fee. This item will be returned at a later date when the new Clerk-Treasurer is hired.

Moved by B. Peterson and seconded by Finnegan to adjourn. Motion carried 5-0. Meeting adjourned at 6:35pm.
