The Public Works Committee for the City of Reedsburg convened for their regular meeting, on January 19, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the Reedsburg Center Conference Room with the following members present:

Motion by Backeberg seconded by Craker to approve the minutes from November 29, 2018 meetings.

Zibell presented a site plan for the proposed Public Works /Parks facility. The committee liked the layout of the main building, salt shed and cold storage building. The site plan presented was on a piece of property east of the current Dog Park. By building in this location a street along with utilities would need to be extended from Wengel Drive at an approximate cost of \$500,000. The Committee felt they didn't want to expend this cost on site work and would rather put this money into the building. All the members thought it would be best to place the building in the southeast corner of Wengel Drive and Zinga Drive. Motion by Craker seconded by Backeberg to locate the new facility on the southeast corner of Wengel Drive and Zinga Drive.

Cameron went over the concept plan and stated he made the changes we brought up during the tours. Cameron also presented another option for the main large truck parking area with the angle parking. He stated to eliminate structural columns in this area the roof design may need to be turned 90 degrees to the main structure. Cameron stated he had another idea for this area and was working with a builder to see how this could be accomplished with no structural columns. Motion by Knudsen seconded by Backeberg to accept the concept plan layout.

Motion Carried

Zibell presented a couple of skid loader quotes from a Mid-States and Fabik. Both machines were comparable and the committee decided to go with the Bobcat from Mid-State Equipment. Motion by Knudsen seconded by Craker to purchase the Bobcat skid loader from Mid-State Equipment.

Motion by Craker seconded by Backeberg to adjourn.
