The Public Works Committee for the City of Reedsburg convened for their regular meeting, on October 17, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. in the Reedsburg Center Conference Room with the following members present:

Members Present: Charlie Backeberg, Brandt Werner and Dave Knudsen

Also Present: Steven Zibell

Motion by Knudsen seconded by Backeberg to approve the minutes from September 19, 2018 meetings.

Motion Carried

Zibell discussed the sewer credit request for 303 Eighth Street. The Committee decided they wanted even more data from this since there isn't much of a difference between the month they are asking a credit for and a normal month. Zibell will ask for another month's bill and will bring it back next month.

No Action

Zibell discussed the sewer credit request for 543 W. Second Street. Zibell stated their hot water heater floated due to the flood and busted the water line. Knudsen thought we should credit any request with this same circumstance the difference between an average sewer bill and the high bill. Motion by Knudsen seconded by Backeberg to use an average of three months prior to the flood and deduct the difference for a credit on anyone requesting this same problem during the flood event this summer.

Motion Carried

Zibell presented 4 different Viking Drive extension options. One option didn't encroach on any airport property and the other options were different geometry affecting both private and airport property. Zibell stated the Airport Commission wanted input from the Public Works Committee and Council before making contact with the Bureau of Aeronautics. The Committee liked the different layouts and preferred something that would work for both the airport and not affecting people's homes. Motion by Werner seconded by Knudsen to keep moving forward to Council and discuss this project with Bureau of Aeronautics.

Motion Carried

Zibell discussed naming Wengel Drive North and South Wengel Drive divided by East Main Street similar to other street in the City. Zibell stated since Wengel Drive has been extended north there may be conflicts with emergency calls. Motion by Knudsen seconded by Backeberg to create a North and South Wengel Drive divided by East Main Street.

Motion Carried

Motion by Werner seconded by Backeberg to adjourn.
