The Public Works Committee for the City of Reedsburg convened for their regular meeting, on November 20, 2019 at 5:30 p.m. in the Reedsburg Center Conference Room with the following members present:

Also Present: Steven Zibell and David Cameron from ADCI

Motion by Knudsen seconded by Backeberg to approve the minutes from October 16, 2019 meetings.

Zibell presented the speed study along Viking Drive taken south of Huntington Park Drive. Zibell stated the 85 percentile speed was close to 30 mph and other things come into consideration such as driveway spacing and traffic volume. Werner asked if the City can restrict turning movement out of some of the driveways along Viking with signs. Zibell stated he would talk to the City Attorney and see if this could be done since they are private driveways. Other ideas were brought up to try and reduce speed and accidents although most would require more funding and reconfiguration of the intersection with Main Street. Zibell stated this could be looked at when and if Viking Drive gets extended to the south. No action was taken at this time.

No Action

Zibell and Cameron discussed the progress of the new Public Works Facility. Knudsen asked if the salt shed could store more salt and sand for future use since the County may be closing their Reedsburg location in a few years. Zibell and Cameron were going to look into the size and the Committee felt we should try and be able to store at least 3 or 4 times of our current storage. Knudsen also asked about possible solar panels along the southerly roof. Cameron stated this was looked at but determined the payback was long since this building won't have a lot of electrical use. Cameron was going to double check the numbers and present them at the next meeting. Overall the Committee was fine with proceeding forward and they also picked out the exterior colors to be a tan/brownish red tone.
