The Public Works Committee for the City of Reedsburg convened for their regular meeting, on November 29, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. in the Reedsburg Center Conference Room with the following members present:

Also Present: Steven Zibell and Dave Cameron

Motion by Backeberg seconded by Craker to approve the minutes from October 17, 2018 meetings.

Cameron presented a concept plan for the proposed Public Works /Parks facility. Cameron and Zibell went over each section along with the uses. There was good discussion amongst the members and staff. The committee also discussed the Mauston and Waunakee buildings plusses and minuses. Cameron will make some changes to the plan as discussed.

No Action

Zibell presented possible locations for the new shop. Friske property was discussed but the committee felt this property would be used more for a residential area and there is a possibility to be isolated during a major flooding event. Some other private sites were also looked at but they are also located near residential areas and the committee felt the Council wants to use land we already own. One possible area discussed was somewhere around the dog park. The members felt this land could be built upon with minimal infrastructure improvements. This area is also planned for light industrial and the City already owns the property. Cameron suggested at least an 8 acre site for future expansion. Motion by Craker seconded by Backeberg to look at siting the new Public Works / Parks facility somewhere in the vicinity around the dog Park south of Zinga Drive and east of Wengel Drive.

Motion Carried

Cameron presented the City Hall bathroom bids. Five bides were opened and the low bid was from T& M General Contractors. Cameron recommended approving the bid from T & M. Motion by Knudsen seconded by Backeberg to approve the bid of \$60,619 from T& M General Contractors.

Motion by Craker seconded by Backeberg to adjourn.
