Narrative

When I arrived on scene I asked Nicole if she or her daughter needed an ambulance. Nicole stated they did not and said they were fine. Nicole stated she was driving to Walgreen's for medicine due to her daughter's illness. Nicole said that her daughter felt as though she was going to vomit so she pulled over into the parking lot of Faith Lutheran Church to allow her daughter to vomit outside of the vehicle. Nicole said when she entered the over-hang area she had her foot pressing the brakes. Nicole said she felt as if she was almost stopped with her foot on the brake so she turned around to help her daughter, and possibly find something in the back for her daughter to use for her illness. Nicole said she turned back around to face forward and hit the handrail of the ramp in front of the church. Nicole's vehicle has damages to the front bumper/fender on the driver side. The handrail has very minor markings and did not appear to be bent nor cracked in any location. Nicole showed me a current Progressive insurance card. I issued Nicole a report information card and ended my contact with Nicole.
