### **Intoxicated Man Arrested After Pointing a Handgun at People**

(REEDSBURG, WI) A Reedsburg man was arrested earlier Sunday morning after pointing a handgun at several people outside a local tavern.

Reedsburg Police were called to the 100 block of S. Walnut Street on June 28th at 2:30am for a report of a male with a gun in front of the tavern. Upon arrival, officers confronted Cruz Soto Sandoval (36) of Reedsburg who told an officer he did not have a firearm on his person. A search of Soto Sandoval revealed a .380 caliber semi-automatic handgun and loaded magazine. According to reports, Soto Sandoval pointed the handgun at multiple people and appeared to be intoxicated.

Soto Sandoval was taken into custody without incident. Soto Sandoval was transported to Sauk County Jail on the following charges: Obstructing an Officer, Disorderly Conduct, Possession of a Firearm While Intoxicated, Carrying a Concealed Weapon and Endangering Safety by Use of a Dangerous Weapon.
