

City of Reedsburg Meeting of the Common Council July 23, 2018

Mayor Dave Estes called the regular session of the Common Council to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Common Council Chambers.

Approve Consent Agenda: consisting the minutes from the Council meeting held on July 9, 2018; Operator's License (New) for Hewitt-Milojevic, Approve Temporary Class "B"/"Class B" Retailers License – Sacred Heart Parish – Fall Festival – Sep. 8 and 9, 2018 – 545 N. - A. Planning Commission: Approve/Deny a Resolution 4345-18. A Resolution of the City Council to approve a Certified Survey Map (CSM) to divide parcel #2408-106 into two lots for two future houses at 415 Midway, Reedsburg WI.
 - a. **Motion: Craker, Second: Moon to approve Resolution 4345-18 as presented. Motion carried 7-0.**
- B. Planning Commission: Approve/Deny a Resolution 4346-18. A Resolution of the City Council to approve a Certified Survey Map (CSM) to attach two parcels #1313 and 1313-01 at 1023 Plum and to divide the main parcel into three separate parcels.
 - a. **Motion: Schulte, Second: Gargano to approve Resolution 4346-18 as presented. Motion carried 7-0.**

Motion carried 7-0.

- D. Ordinance Committee: 2nd reading and hold Public Hearing for Ordinance 1875-18. An Ordinance to amend Chapter 29.09 and 29.10 also adding Chapter 17.22. Amend Chapter 29.09, 29.10 to change a term to “Animals at large” and adding section 17.22 Section 7 for Chickens to the ordinance. Allows by zoning code with annual license.
- a. **Motion: Gargano, Second: Braunschweig to approve Ordinance 1875-18 with the exclusion of the requirement to have 50% of contiguous neighbors approve the license as well. Motion carried 6-1 with Craker casting the dissenting vote.**
- E. Planning Commission: 2nd reading and hold Public Hearing for Ordinance 1876-18. An Ordinance to amend Chapter 17.13 Section 9, (‘C’), (1) to make changes to the owner occupancy of home businesses in R-1, R-2, or B-3 zoned rentals by owners consent.
- a. **Motion: Schulte, Second: Gargano to approve Ordinance 1876-18 as presented. Motion carried 7-0.**
- F. Ordinance Committee: 2nd reading and hold Public Hearing for Ordinance 1877-18. An Ordinance to amend Chapter 12.01: Intoxicating Liquor and Fermented Malt Beverages. Amend Chapter 12.01 Section 3 – Operator’s Licenses.
- a. **Motion: Knudsen, Second: Craker to approve Ordinance 1877-18 as presented. Motion carried 7-0.**
- G. Ordinance Committee: Introduction, 1st reading and setting Public Hearing for August 13, 2018 for Ordinance 1878-18. An ordinance amending Chapter 11 Health and Sanitation, amending section 11.01, removing sections 11.13 and 11.14.
- a. **Motion: Peterson, Second: Moon to approve setting the public hearing for Ordinance 1878-18. Motion carried 7-0.**
- H. Ordinance Committee: Introduction, 1st reading and setting Public Hearing for August 13, 2018 for Ordinance 1879-18. An ordinance amending Chapter 10.03 Public Nuisances Affecting Public Health, amending several sections in Chapter 10 and removing duplication found in Chapter 11.
- a. **Motion: Moon, Second: Schulte to approve setting the public hearing for Ordinance 1879-18. Motion carried 7-0.**
- I. Ordinance Committee: Introduction, 1st reading and setting Public Hearing for August 13, 2018 for Ordinance 1880-18. An ordinance amending Chapter 7 Traffic Code, Amending section 7.08(5) changing the time for parking upon city streets and alleys. A revision is also being recommended to provide authority to the Public Works Committee to deliver a City Resolution for City Names, placement of stop signs, street directions and parking.
- a. **Motion: Gargano, Second: Craker to approve setting the public hearing for Ordinance 1880-18. Motion carried 7-0.**
